In today's Gospel, we hear of the seven truths about the Word: 1) the Word is **Eternal**. John is making a deliberate reference to Genesis 1:1, "In the beginning..." He wanted his readers to know that the Word was with them now as well; 2) the Word is **Personality**. The Word is a personal being, present with God in the beginning. There was a relationship with the Word and God; 3) the Word is **Deity**. John writes, "...and the Word was God." Here John is making

tionship with the Word and God; 3) the Word is **Deity**. John writes, "...and the Word was God." Here John is making a distinction between two beings, which is part of the mystery of the unity with the Godhead; 4) the Word is **Creating**. It was the Word who created all things and John affirms that the Word is the creator because "all things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being"; 5) the Word is **Animating**. Verse 4 says, "In him was life." The Word, the second person of the Godhead, has life in himself, is the one who creates life, and there is no life apart from the Word; 6) the Word is **Revealing**. The Word not only gives life, but gives light too. The Word guides his creatures by the light of his truth into a right relationship with himself; and 7) the Word is **Incarnate**. "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us." John is intentionally helping his readers understand that God was dwelling physically among them once again, in the person of Jesus. Thus, John establishes the point at which he was aiming throughout the passage: the Son of God *is* the Word of God. The Word's ultimate purpose was to die in order to purchase salvation for sinners. He did so, and God accepted his sacrifice by raising him from the dead.

The Stone Was Rolled Away!

veryone knows what a magician is and the many tricks he or she can do. You have probably seen magicians on TV or even at a special assembly program at school or at the circus. Most of the time, a magi-Cian always has an assistant who helps him or her perform tricks. A favourite one is when the magician would put his or her assistant into a trunk, lock it, and tie ropes around it, then tap the trunk with his or her wand, until the ropes, unlock and open the lid...and voilà -- the trunk was empty.

On the Sunday morning after Jesus was crucified, two women named Mary went to visit the tomb where Jesus had been buried. When they arrived, there was a great earthquake and an angel Came and rolled away the huge stone that had been covering the entrance to Jesus' tomb. The angel sat on the stone and said to the two women, "Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus Who was crucified. He is not here; for He has been raised, as He said. Come, see the place where He lay." You see, the stone was not rolled away so that Jesus could get out of the grave, it was rolled away so that His followers could go in and see that the tomb was empty.

Now, we know that the magician making his or her assistant disappear from the trunk is just a trick, but the empty tomb of Jesus was not a trick. Jesus had risen, just as He said He would! Today we celebrate the fact that the stone was rolled away, not so Jesus could come out, but so that we could see that He has risen from the grave, and because of His victory over death, we can enter into eternal life with Him.

Heavenly Father, we are thankful that the stone has been rolled away and because the grave is empty, we can enter into eternal life with You. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.
